What can you do to help at home?

- 1. Use pure sounds rather than letter names.
- 2. Teach the picture names.
- 3. Practise reading sounds speedily.
- 4. Use the handwriting phrases to practise writing.
- 5. Share the reading ditty sheets/decodable books that your child brings home.

How do I use the Virtual Classroom?

- 1. Set aside 10 minutes to watch a film with your child each day.
- 2. Find a quiet space for your child to watch the film on a laptop or tablet.
- 3. Praise your child as they join in with the lesson make it fun!
