What can you do to help at home?


- 1. Practise saying the sounds and the phrase.
- 2. Practise reading sounds speedily.
- 3. Help your child to use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk' to read words containing the sounds.
- 4. Practice reading the decodable book that your child brings home to build up fluency.
